Page 3 – Change class numbers from 100 series to 300 series.

Page 4 – Added definition for FEI MFS:

*For this show, **Class 362 FEI MFS TOC** is for FEI Intermediate I MFS, FEI Intermediate A/B MFS, and FEI Grand Prix MFS tests only.*

Page 5 – Added **\$15 Non-Equestrian Entries Entry** fee for each entry submitted without using Equestrian Entries online system.

Page 6 – Line 14 – Added “\$15 fee for these entries.”

Page 6 – Last para – Clarified refunds policy:

**REFUNDS.** *Entry scratches received BEFORE midnight of the original published closing date or the actual closing date/time, whichever is earlier, will be refunded less the full office fee. Overpayments greater than \$25 will be refunded if verified before this closing date. There will be no refunds, for any reason, after this closing date, including show cancellation due to Acts of God, acts of terrorism, inclement weather, and/or other emergencies.*

Page 3 – Added Materiale classes:

372	\$40	USDF Materiale 4-5 YO Mares / not USDFBC Q (see definitions)

Page 4 – Added Materiale definition:

<b>Materiale</b>	For this show, the Materiale classes are <b>not</b> USDF Breeders Championship Series (USDFBC) qualifying classes. Horses will be evaluated according to the criteria listed on the USDF Materiale Class Scoresheet. Horses will be evaluated under saddle at the walk, trot and canter in both directions of the arena. No more than six horses will be asked to canter at one time. Four and five-year old horses may be asked to lengthen the stride at the trot and canter. Horses must be at least 36 months of age to participate in Materiale classes. Materiale classes may not be divided to allow one rider to ride more than one horse. Horses must have either a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) or USDF Horse Identification Number (HID) and owners must submit identification information. Horses registered with a breed organization should have a copy of their registration papers submitted directly to USDF. Owner/Rider/Trainer USDF membership requirements will be as for USDF recognized shows.
