Rules and Entry Information:

- Classes may be combined or split at manager's discretion. (Stakes classes will only be combined with other Stakes classes. Entering two stakes tests per level may mean you will ride two tests in the class.)
- 2018 USEA Eventing Tests, 2019 USDF/USEF (2017 West. Dress) Tests and Current FEI Tests will be used. Gaited entrants must send a copy of the test with entry.
- Introductory (USDF and West. Dress) Level and USEA Beginner Novice through Preliminary A will be ridden in a small (20m X 40m) arena. All other tests will be ridden in a standard (20m X 60m) arena.
- Casual attire. All humans must wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets while mounted.
- Ride times will be posted on the website, www.bychancefarm.com by the Thursday before the show.
- Entry Fees: Regular Classes 1-9: \$25 per ride Stakes Classes upgrade: \$10 per ride
- Prizes: Ribbons through 6th place. Special Prizes will be identified on the website.
- Stakes Classes will pay 1st – 40%, 2nd – 30%, 3rd – 20%, 4th – 10%
- In the case of over subscription, please note first choice of test/class on entry form.
- A portion of the proceeds from the October show will benefit the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation, www.cff.org.
- Returned check fee of \$35.
- Scratches before the closing date will receive a full refund. Scratches after the closing date only if entry can be filled from wait list. No shows are required to pay all entry fees or may be put on a banned list from all FADS affiliate shows. Please let us know if you can't make it!
- Please provide horse, rider and owner USDF numbers in order to participate in the USDF Regional Schooling Show Awards program.
