**Class 150**: Changed description so all Training through 4<sup>th</sup> level tests may be ridden only for a same additional test as another Tr-4<sup>th</sup> class.

#### 5. DEFINITIONS:

GAIG: Updated link to 2021 GAIG/USDF rules.

**USEF TOC (Class 150):** Updated text to read: This class is for any Tr, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, or 4th level test and is only for entries also entered for the same test in classes 101, 102, 103, 111, 112, 113, 121, 122, 123, 131, 132, 133, 141, 142 or 143. The class provides riders a second opportunity to ride a same test a second time and to attain a BLM or GAIG qualifying score at this show (tests 2 and 3, respectively). For GAIG, only one of the scores attained at this show may count as a qualifying score: "To qualify for a Regional Championship, horse/rider combinations must earn a total of two qualifying scores (each score must be the average of all judges officiating in a designated Great American/USDF qualifying class), at two different USEF-licensed/USDF Recognized Dressage Competitions, from two different judges, or combination of judges."

**MATERIALE**: Updated to read: Since this show does not offer qualifying materiale classes, riders and owners are not required to be USDF members; however, if they are not members, they must pay the USDF non-member fees, as usual. Horses will be evaluated according to the criteria listed on the USDF Materiale Class Scoresheet. Horses will be evaluated under saddle at the walk, trot and canter in both directions of the arena. No more than six horses will be asked to canter at one time. Four and five-year old horses may be asked to lengthen the stride at the trot and canter. Horses must be at least 36 months of age to participate in Materiale classes. Materiale classes may not be divided to allow one rider to ride more than one horse.

**MATERIALE**: Updated to read: Horses will be evaluated according to the criteria listed on the USDF Materiale Class Scoresheet. Horses will be evaluated under saddle at the walk, trot and canter in both directions of the arena. No more than six horses will be asked to canter at one time. Four and five-year old horses may be asked to lengthen the stride at the trot and canter. Horses must be at least 36 months of age to participate in Materiale classes. Materiale classes may not be divided to allow one rider to ride more than one horse.
